Bond Release Inspection General Guidelines

- 1. Sidewalk, curb/gutter, storm drains, and roadways must be clean and without damage.
- 2. No patching or filling of damaged areas permitted.
- 3. Small surface damages, such as chips or spalls, may be corrected by grinding area to match surrounding surfaces. (Maximum size = less than 3 sq.in. and not deeper than 1/4".)
- 4. All cracked curb/gutter and sidewalks must be replaced. Replaced sections must meet City standards. (Also, note that the minimum distance between expansion/control joints must be 48".)
- 5. Gutter replacement does not require the cutting of roadway. If the roadway is damaged during the removal of gutter, a minimum of 12" of asphalt must be cut and replaced (from edge of gutter toward center of roadway and to include the full length plus 24" of replaced concrete).
- 6. Cutting of curb/gutter is allowed for replacement (minimum 48" between expansion/control joints). Any cuts made into the asphalt must be filled with an approved material.
- 7. Uneven or displaced sections (uneven at control/expansion joints) must be corrected.
- 8. Quality of finished surface on replaced concrete must meet City standards.
- 9. All markings must be replaced in original locations (P.I., sewer, water, property, pins).
- 10. All bond release inspections must be completed and approved within nine (9) months after issuance of "certificate of occupancy" or bond will be forfeited to the City of Cedar Hills.
